

INFORMATION TO COMPETITORS REGARDING SCORE CONTINGENCY

What is Contingency?? What are the requirements?? How do I get paid?? Who is responsible for the inspection and the set up of Contingency Row?? These and many other questions will be answered in this bulletin.

The term “Contingency” relates to the use of product(s) and decal(s) on race vehicles. A manufacturer or off-road product company (known as the Contingency Donor) then pays a declared amount of monies/product/services to a competitor who qualifies (see requirements below).

Contingency Requirements are:

- 1 - Exclusive use of the companies product and decals.
- 2 - Fill out a “declaration of intent” form provided by the company
- 3 - Prominent display of the companies actual decals (NO DIE-CUTS). These decals MUST be placed on each side of the race vehicle(NOT in fenderwells, under fenders, roofs, hoods or on skid plates). Some Contingency Donors may also require their decals placement on the windshield or forward portion of the roof . These decals can be obtained from the companies that are present on Contingency Row or from them prior to the event.
- 4 - The product and decals must be on the race vehicle when you start and when you finish the event.
- 5 - All race vehicles are REQUIRED to go through Contingency Row, the day before the race, and surrender a READABLE Contingency Declaration Form to a Contingency team member. Contingency Donors are not required to pay monies/product/services to competitors that miss Contingency Row.

FINISH LINE - At the finish line, of the event, the Contingency Director will use the Declaration Form as a guide to inspect the race vehicle for the declared product(s) and decals. The Contingency Director will then verify, on the form, that the Contingency Donors requirement have or have NOT been met. The Contingency Director will then notify the Contingency Donors of those race competitors that have met their requirements and qualify for payment of monies/products/services. The Contingency Donor will then provide the awards to the race competitors. NOTE!! This process could be delayed because the original submitted Declaration Form was unreadable or did not have the required information. Social Security information is needed by the companies BEFORE any checks can issued. **SCORE INTERNATIONAL** assumes no responsibility for the payment of any Contingency money/product/services.

The Contingency Row setup and location is a joint effort between **SCORE International** and the host city. Local laws/ordinances affect where/when and how we set up the row.

Local civic groups are welcomed into Contingency Row. Major sponsors are welcome to participate as well. Most often the entire town will turn out for the carnival-like atmosphere of Contingency Row. We at **SCORE** feel that this benefits everyone involved with our sport of Off-Road racing. The exposure and the scope of **SCORE International's** Contingency Row is unique to our sport.

Hopefully this letter will enlighten on **SCORE International's** Contingency program.
